COMPACT TO TRAILER

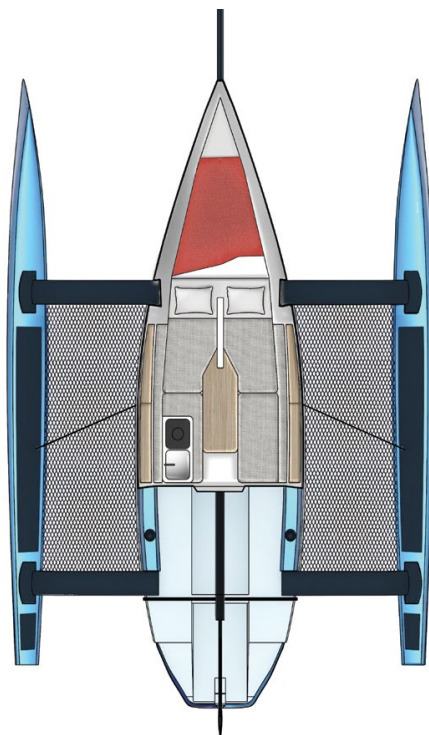

Equally, at the end of the day, your Corsair 760 can be de-rigged and on its trailer ready for the return home in as much time.

Your Corsair 760 might feel like a big yacht on the water, but folded on a trailer it is just 24ft by 8ft and easy to trailer on the road & store between use in the garage or car port. With a road trailer and even loaded with gear for the days sailing it requires only a medium sized vehicle to be safe & legal on the road.
